# IV. TIME OF CONTESTS

- A. 2 SITES/Weekday Modified "A" 5:30 PM JV -5:30 PM
  - a. VARSITY 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Junior Varsity game.
- B. 2 SITES/Saturday Modified "A" 11:00AM / JV 11:00AM
  - a. VARSITY 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Junior Varsity game.
- C. 1 SITE/Weekday Modified "A" 4:30 PM 15 minutes after the conclusion of the JV game.
  - a. Varsity 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Junior Varsity game.
- D. 1 SITE/Saturday Modified "A" 11:00AM –15 minutes after the conclusion of the JV game.
  - a. Varsity 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Junior Varsity game.

NOTE: Anytime there are only 2 games scheduled the games will begin at 5:30 on weekdays and 11:00AM on Saturdays.

## V. OFFICIAL EQUIPMENT

Official game balls must be as specified on the "official ball" listing provided by the Council of Athletic Directors. See General By-laws – V. OFFICIAL EQUIPMENT

#### VI. UNIFORMS

Home teams shall wear light jerseys and the visiting team dark jerseys unless a change is mutually acceptable to both coaches.

# VII. ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION

- A. Modified "A" is for 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders. See NYSPHSAA Handbook for specifics. Modified "B" is for 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>. Graders. See NYSPHSAA Handbook for specifics.
- B. Junior Varsity cannot be in their last two years of eligibility unless they meet APP requirements and are approved by the Council of Athletic Directors.
- C. Varsity players may include anyone qualified above.

# VIII. HOME TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Provide an official timer (Recommend an adult).
- B. Provide an official scorer (Recommend an adult).
- C. Provide special timers as may be required by rules (Recommend an adult).
- D. Game ball
- E. Locker room facilities for the visiting team.
- F. Notification of media at the end of game.

# IX. POSTPONEMENTS & CANCELLATIONS

- A. Home schools are responsible for notifying the visiting school as early as possible before game time if a postponement is necessary.
- B. Home schools are responsible for notifying the assignor and game officials of postponements and rescheduled games.

# XIV. LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- A. Determined by General By-Laws XII. DIVISION OR LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP
- B. The following process will be used when a champion cannot be determined using the General By-Laws:
  - a. Fewest first-half points given up in head to head league contests.
  - b. Resolve to a shared league championship

#### XVI. ADDITIONAL

- A. The CVAC Council of Athletic Directors recommends a reading of the Sportsmanship passage from the CVAC Guidelines before the first home varsity event of the season.
- B. Visiting coaches with a home team representative should conduct a pre & post game locker room check for damages.
- C. Pep Bands and Cheerleaders

- a. If a visiting school wishes to bring a pep band, they must receive permission from the host school prior to the date of the game.
- b. Permission for pep bands at CVAC post season games and playoffs must be granted permission by the Sport Chairperson and the neutral site school.
- c. Pep bands will not interfere with the normal play of the game. They may perform before the game, during time-outs and intermissions.
- D. Music may be played by the home team.
- E. Choice of baskets is now determined by both rule books.
- F. The visiting team shall take the floor first and should do so at a reasonable time after the preceding game.
- G. Any pre-game or half time ceremonies which would delay the game- the visiting school should be notified in advance.
- H. Teams returning to the floor early at half time shall respect the Cheerleading routine in progress.
- I. Coaches and players should make every effort to shake hands at the conclusion of the game.
- J. Modified "A" practices will begin 1 week following the approved start date for Varsity and JV.

  - 3. The Sports Chairperson will be responsible for making all arrangements for the game.
